

## CC-Cars gets new management and ownership Founder Christian Jensen has chosen to step down

18 years ago Christian Jensen founded CC-Cars in Ans, and since then the company has grown to not only become Scandinavia's largest classic car dealer, but has also become a major agent on the European market. Now the founder has chosen to step down from the day-to-day management.

"CC-Cars is in a very healthy state," Christian Jensen says. "In parallel to the classic car dealership I am also involved in a number of other projects that are really time consuming, so it was a good idea to reduce the number of tasks I have at our store in Ans."

"Three years ago we expanded with a new store in Odense, run by Kristian Grünhut Liborius who is also among the owners there. He has really succeeded in turning the department into a success, and I am very happy to let him take over the overall management of CC-Cars."

"I bought my first classic car from Christian Jensen back in 2016," Kristian Grünhut Liborius says. That kickstarted their current corporation. "We have the same passion for classic cars and the same business philosophy, so when I suggested that the company should be expanded with a store in Odense, Christian Jensen immediately liked the idea."

In 2017 the CC-Cars store on Funen was established with Kristian Grünhot Liborius as the director. Now he gets the same role at the store in Ans.

"Even though I stop as managing director, I will continue to be an active part of CC-Cars," Christian Jensen says. "I am still a part of the ownership as well as a member of the board, where I will work for our future development. And off course I will still be present in the Ans store – but not every day – while I will continue to service some of CC-Cars' loyal and long-lasting clients."

"I will still be based in Odense, but off course I will often be at the store in Ans," Kristian Grünhut Liberious says. He has also become part-owner of CC-Cars.

"I have been in this business for four years now and I have had a fantastic teacher in Christian Jensen, who has introduced me to the business of buying and selling classic cars. It is important for me that CC-Cars will continue with the same mindset. We are not talking about a revolution but an evolution of the company," Kristian Grünhut Liborius says.
